The Henley Boat Races are a showcase for women's rowing and each year attract up to 10,000 supporters at the venue in Henley-on-Thames. This year's event takes place on Sunday 23rd March 2008. Each year, Cambridge University Women's Boat Club enters three crews containing the University's 27 most talented oarswomen to compete against their Oxford University counterparts on the Henley Reach. To date, CUWBC has a win rate of 75 to Oxford's 46.
